No.1/37-PSPB(PC)-2012/ 4196 dated 31-10-2012 The Unique Identification Authority of India(UIDAI) has been entrusted with the responsibility of issuing UID Number(Aadhaar) to all the residents of India to define usage and applicability of Aadhaar for delivery of various services. The basic objective of Aadhaar is to improve delivery of government services to the citizens through Aadhaar based services delivery mechanism.

2. Department of Planning, Punjab is functioning as nodal department for the implementation of Aadhaar project and Department of Food & Civil Supplies, Punjab has been declared as Registrar for the enrollment of all the residents. The enrollment of residents for getting Aadhaar is going on throughout the state.

3. The state government has taken a decision to officially recognize Aadhaar being given to the residents as valid document for establishing Proof of Identity (POI) for various services being offered by the state government to the residents of Punjab.

4. Accordingly, all the departments are hereby requested to adopt Aadhaar as valid document for Proof of Identity(POI) and issue suitable instructions in this regard.
