2. Construction of vented pipe crossing over a Nallah X-ing Border track in between B.O.P. Jaitpur and Paharipur under 171 Bn.BSF Block Narot Jaimal Singh.	Construction of 2 Span 10' each culverts vented causeway (22' wide) on Basheria Nallah crossing Border Track near BSF forward Post, Bamial.

2. The terms and condition of the sanction shall however, remain the same. The new work may be completed within the approved amount and no additional funds shall be provided for the same.

3. The ex-post facto approval of State Level Screening Committee on Border Area Development Programme for the change of this work shall be obtained in the next meeting of SLSC. This proposal has been approved by the Chief Secretary Punjab, as Chairman of SLSC on BADP.
