



I am directed to forward herewith a copy of Planning Commission's (MLP Division's) letter No.M-13053/6/2/2011-MLP dated 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2012 alongwith its enclosures on the subject mentioned above and to state that a team of officers of Planning Commission led by Shri B.D. Viridi, Adviser (MLP), Planning Commission, visited the border areas of Guru Dera Baba Nanak and Dinanagar blocks of Gurdaspur district from 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2012 to 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2012. Based on the tour to these border blocks and discussions with the local people and the district authorities, four schemes have been identified by the above said team which would fill critical gaps in infrastructure with a total estimated cost of Rs.5.44 crore.

2. Since, schemes under BADP are formulated and approved by the State Level Screening Committee (SLSC) headed by the Chief Secretary of the State, it is requested that the feasibility of schemes may be examined and placed before the SLSC for approval and inclusion in the Annual Action Plan of BADP for the current financial year.
