2. The headquarters of the committee shall be at Chandigarh. The committee shall meet from time to time and at a place to be decided by the chairman of the committee.

3 The functions of the committee shall be as under:-

- i) The Committee will broadly scrutinize the criteria for declaring the backward areas;
- ii) The Committee will select the areas to be included for processing for declaration of backward area;
- iii) The committee will recommend the area to be declared as backward in District Sangrur or any other area in Punjab specifically ordered by the Government;
- iv) Any other related functions that may be assigned by the Government regarding Backward Area;

4 The term of the committee will be for the period of three years.
