Subject: Community Welfare Budget for welfare of Border Population – Scheme regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to state that it has been reported by the Police Division of this Ministry that a substantial amount is being provided to the Border Guarding Forces in their Budget for welfare activities to benefit the border population. It has, therefore, been decided that the Border Guarding Forces may not be provided any funds for Civic Action Programme/Community Welfare Schemes under BADP. The BGFs may, however, be provided up to 10% of funds under BADP for security related developmental activities for the following purposes:-

- (i) Construction of Link roads/approach roads to BOPs;
- (ii) Construction of buildings for BOPs;
- (iii) Construction of building for Police Stations/Police Posts etc;
- (iv) Construction of residential units for Police/security personnel;
- (v) For supplying drinking water to BOPs;
- (vi) For making provisions of electricity to BOPs/Police Stations etc;
- (vii) Any other work relating to raising of infrastructure;

3. The funds under BADP for SRE may, however, not be provided for the following purposes:-

- (i) Purchase of weapons;
- (ii) Purchase of equipments of bomb disposal units and forensic science equipments;
- (iii) Purchase of Night vision devises;
- (iv) Purchase of vehicles for Border Guarding Forces/Local Police Forces.

4. The aforesaid instructions may be kept in view while finalizing the security related schemes forwarded by Border Guarding Forces/Local Police for funding under BADP.
