#### **PREFACE**

The data relating to number of Government Employees in the state is being collected regularly on annual basis, in accordance with the recommendations of the Joint Conference of the Central and State Statisticians held in 1951 at New Delhi. It includes the number of employees working in Government, Semi-Government, and Aided Institutions as well as Boards, Corporations and Local Bodies, etc.

In the present report, the data in respect of Government employees has been given under different categories such as group A, B, C & D, work charged, contingency paid and on contract basis, department-wise and district-wise, according to pay scales as well as male/female. The Number of Government Semi-Government and Aided Institutions employees belonging to scheduled castes, backward classes, exservicemen, wards of freedom fighters, handicapped, terrorist affected and employed on compassionate ground in position as on 31.3.2010 has also been given separately.

As on 31.3.2010, the employees for Government sector, Semi-Government and Aided Institutions were 320761, 112234 & 12179 respectively. Out of total 445174 employees there were 113367 (25.47%) female employees.

Although, the number of Government employees which were 375448 as on 31.3.2000 are 320761 have declined from 324164 as on 31.3.2009 by 3403.

I acknowledge the co-operation provided by all Heads of Departments, Boards, Corporations, Local Bodies and Deputy Economic and Statistical Advisers, in the districts far furnishing the desired information. This report has been prepared under the guidance and supervision of Smt.Sarbjit Kaur Research Officer, Sh. Pritpal Singh,Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser and under over all guidance and supervision of Sh. Parminder Singh Walia, Director.

As there is always scope for improvement, I would sincerely welcome suggestions for improvement.

#### **REVIEW**

The report on Census of Punjab Govt. and Semi-Govt. employees as on 31<sup>st</sup> March is prepared on an annual basis. Semi-Govt. employees include employees working in Boards, Corporations and Local Bodies such as Municipal Corporations/ Municipal Committees Improvement Trusts, Zila Parishads, Market Committees and Panchayat Samities. This report has been divided into three parts i.e. Part-A, B & C which relate to Number of Government employees, Semi-Government and Aided Institutions employees respectively.

#### Part-A - Government Employees

#### Introduction

In this Part, information regarding Government employees has been given in 12 tables which includes the following aspects:-

- a. Total number of Government employees and increase/decrease over time.
- b. Department-wise and District-wise Government employees according
- scales, groups and sex etc.
- c. Number of reserve category employees and Compassionate ground employees.
- d. Total Estimated Expenditure incurred on salaries/wages.

#### II. Scope and Coverage

Census of Government employees covers all the State Govt. employees (permanent, temporary, contingency paid, work-charged or on contract basis) as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010.

#### III. Methodology

A set of prescribed proformae was circulated to all the heads of various Departments located at Chandigarh. The information was collected either by post or personally by the staff of Demography Section. At district level, O/o Deputy Economic and Statistical Advisers collected this information from the offices located in their respective districts. To make this report more useful the information of various departments has been further classified into General Services, Social Services and Economic services.

#### IV. Limitations

This report is based on the information supplied by the concerned Departments, Boards, Corporations and Local Bodies located at Chandigarh as well as in the districts.

#### V. Results

Total No. of employees as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010 was 320761 against 324164 as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2009 showing a decline of 1.05 % over the previous year.

The employees have been classified in group 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' on the basis of following norms:

- **Group-A** Posts having an initial entry Revised pay scales of Rs. 10300-34800+5000 or more provided that all existing class-I posts irrespective of monetary limits of the pay scales shall be placed in group 'A'.
- **Group-B** Posts falling between an initial entry revised pay scales of pay Rs. 10300-34800+3800 and 10300-34800+4800.
- **Group-C** Posts falling between an initial entry revised pay scales of Rs. 5910-20200+1900 and10300-34800+3600.
- **Group-D** Posts falling between initial entry revised pay scales of Rs. 4900-10680+1300 and 10300-34800+1650.

The group-wise total No. of employees in the State Government as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010 is as under:-

- Group A -10768
- Group B -20833
- Group C 191432
- Group D 56805
- Contingency paid, Work charged and Contract basis 40923

Groupwise /Categorywise analysis of Number of Government employees is given as below:

#### 1. Group-A

The No. of class-I officers was 10275 as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2000 and which rose to 10768 as on 31.3. 2010. Out of total Group-A officers as on 31.3. 2010, maximum 2517 were in the pay scales of Rs. 10300-34800+5000 followed by 1732 in the pay scale of Rs. 10300-34800+5400. A No. of 1227 Group-A officers were posted at Chandigarh and 9541 were working in the districts. Maximum No. of Group-A officers i.e. 1422 were working in district Patiala and minimum No. of group-A officers i.e. 133 were in district Barnala.

Department-wise analysis depicts that the maximum No. 3596 of Group A officers were in Health Department followed by Education Department 1861, Animal Husbandry 692, Agriculture 599 Irrigation 444, Police 425.

#### 2. Group-B

The total No. of Class-II officers were 4906 as on 31.3. 2000 and which has increased to 20833 as on 31.3. 2010 Maximum No. of Group-B officers i.e. 10620 were in pay scale of Rs. 10300-34800+3800. Highest No. of group-B officers were in Gurdaspur district with 2088 officers and lowest No. were in district TarnTaran with 200 officers. Education Department was having the maximum No. of 9738 Group-B officers as on 31.3. 2010.

#### 3. Group-C

There were 256105 Class-III employees as on 31.3. 2000 which has decreased to 191432 as on 31.3.2010. The index for group-C employees stood at 74.74 as on 31.3. 2010 as compared to the base year 2000 which indicates a net decrease of 25.26%. Maximum No. of employees 50429 were working in the pay scale of Rs. 5910-20200+1900 as on 31.3. 2010.

So far as the place of posting of Group-C employees at district level were concerned, district Patiala was having maximum 20266 employees as on 31.3. 2010. The lowest No. of 2998 employees were in district S.A.S Nagar. Out of the total group-C employees 125867 employees were employed in the two main departments of the State Govt. i.e. Education 73914 (38.61 %) and Police 51953(27.14 %).

#### 4. Group-D

There were 65984 class-IV Govt. employees as on 31.3.2000 which has increased to 56805 as on 31.3. 2010. Index for 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2000 to 31.3.2010 was 86.09 which show net decrease of 13.91%.

Out of total 56805 group-D employees in the State as on 31.3. 2010 a maximum No. 36533employees were in the pay scale of Rs.4900-10680+1300. 53988 employees were working in districts and 2817 were working at Chandigarh as on 31.3. 2010. Amongst the districts, Gurdaspur district was having maximum No. of 7368 group-D employees. Amongst the departments, Irrigation Department was having maximum 11986 group-D employees followed by Health Department 10153 employees and Education Department 8635 employees.

#### 5. Contingency Paid, Work Charged and Contract Basis Employees

The No. of contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees increased to 40923 as on 31.3.2010 from 38178 as on 31.3.2000. Index for these employees was 107.19 as on 31.3.2010 depicting a net increase of 7.19% with 31.3.2000 base year. There were 38178 contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees as on 31.3. 2000.

Out of total 40923 employees as on 31.3. 2010, 442 were working at Chandigarh and the remaining 40481 were working in the districts. Maximum No. of 6360 contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees were employed in Gurdaspur district.

Social Welfare and welfare of SC's and BC's Department employed the maximum No.19203 (46.92%) of contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees followed by Education Department 7281 (17.79%), Police Department 4184 (10.22 %).

#### 6. Female Employees

Out of total 320761 Govt. employees as on 31.3. 2010, there were 95705 (29.84%) female employees. Out of total 31601 group A and B officers, 8964 (28.37%) were females and 22637 (71.63%) were males. Education Department and Health Department were having maximum female employees of group A and B i.e. 5417 and 1324 respectively.

Out of total 289160 group-C, group-D, contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees, 202419 (70.00 %) were males and 86741 (30.00 %) were females. Education (42765), Social Welfare (18834), Health (11818) and Irrigation (2180) were the main departments having females group C,D, contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees.

# 7. Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex- Servicemen, Wards of Freedom Fighters, Handicapped, Terrorist affected and Compassionate ground Employees

Information regarding the No. of employees belonging to Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen, Wards of Freedom Fighters, Handicapped, Terrorist affected and Compassionate ground in the service as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010 was collected from the concerned departments. There were 320761 filled up posts of govt. employees as on 31.3. 2010. In the following

paragraphs the analysis for SC's, BC's, Ex-Servicemen, Wards of Freedom Fighters, Handicapped, Terrorists affected and Compassionate ground employees has been made for 279838 filled up posts. 40923 contingency paid, work charged and on contract basis employees have not been included in this analysis.

#### i. Number of Scheduled Castes Government Employees

Out of total 279838 filled up posts of Government employees 71539 (25.56 %) belonged to scheduled castes as on 31.3. 2010. Group-wise No. of scheduled castes Govt. employees were 1827 (16.97%) in group-A, 3740 (17.95 %) in group-B, 45505 (23.77 %) in group-C and 20467 (36.03 %) in group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

#### ii. Number of Backward Classes Government employees

Out of total 279838 Government employees, 28213 (10.08 %) belong to backward classes as on 31.3. 2010. Group-wise Number of these employees were 510 (4.74 %) in group-A, 1732 (8.31 %) in group-B, 19492 (10.18 %) in group-C and 6479 (11.40 %) in group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

#### iii. Number of Ex-servicemen Govt. Employees

Out of total 279838 filled up posts of Government Employees, 3726 (1.33%) belong to Ex-servicemen as on 31.3. 2010. So for as group-wise classification the number of ex-servicemen Government employees were 33 (0.31%) in Group A, 78 (0.37%) in group-B, 2914(1.52%) in group-C and 701 (1.23%) in group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

#### iv. Number of Wards of Freedom Fighters Employees

Out of total 279838 filled up posts, 348 (0.12 %) Govt. Employees belong to this category. Group-wise number of such employees were 10 (0.09 %) in group-A, 15(0.07 %) in group-B,226(0.12 %) in group-C and 97 (0.17 %) in Group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

#### v. Number of Handicapped Govt. Employees

Out of total 279838 filled up posts, 2650(0.95%) Government employees were handicapped as on 31.3.2010. There were 58 (0.54 %) employees in Group-A, 233 (1.12 %) in Group-B, 1489 (0.78 %) in Group-C and 870 (1.53 %) in Group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

#### vi. Number of Terrorist affected Govt. Employees

Out of the total 279838 filled up posts, 2309(0.82 %) Government employees were terrorist affected as on 31.3. 2010, having 8 employee(0.07%) in group A, 41(0.20 %) in group-B, 1408 (0.73 %) in group C and 852 (1.50 %) in group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

#### vii. Number of Compassionate ground Employees

Out of the total 279838 filled up posts, 7389 (2.64%) Government employees were employed on compassionate grounds as on 31.3.2010. There were 22 employees (0.20 %) in Group-A, 230 (1.10 %) in group-B, 4365 (2.28 %) in group-C and 2772 (4.88 %) in group-D. (Percentage derived from the total filled employees of the same group).

# 8. Number of Employees Employed, Retired, Terminated, Dismissed, Resigned and Died during the year

During the year 2009-10, 2532 employees were employed and 7290 employees were retired. 802 employees were either terminated or dismissed or resigned or died during the said year.


#### 9. Estimated Expenditure on Government Employees

It was decided to collect information regarding expenditure on Government employees in each pay scale as per the instructions issued during the year 2001 by Department of Finance. Although, efforts were made to collect information in respect of expenditure on salary from the concerned departments but the information was not received from all the concerned quarters despite the best efforts. Therefore, estimated expenditure on salary of employees was calculated during the year 2009-10. First of all mid-value of the pay scale has been taken as its basic pay and was multiplied by the total No. of employees (as on 31st March) to get total monthly basic pay. The total medical allowance is worked out by multiplying the total No. of govt. employees with fixed medical allowance. To get total dearness allowance first of all the dearness allowance given during the financial year 2009-10 is added then total is divided by 12 to get one month average rate of dearness allowance and thereafter multiplied by total basic pay of each pay scale. To get total monthly pay of one pay scale column No.5,6,7 were added and multiplied by 12 to get estimated annual expenditure on salaries of that pay scale. Thus total estimated monthly expenditure on salaries of 320761 govt. employees was Rs. 443.23 crores and annual expenditure was Rs. 5318.77 crores and annual expenditure per employee was 1.66 lakh for the year 2009-10. Detail is given in table No.12.

The No. of Employees were 1672 per lakh of population as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 1995 which has decreased to 1117 as on 31-03-2010. It indicates that overtime Employees ratio to population is decreasing.



#### Part-B

#### Introduction

The data relating to Semi- Government employees as on 31.3. 2010 working in Boards, Corporations, Municipal Corporations/Committees, Improvement Trusts, Zila Parishads, Market Committees and Panchayat Samities was collected and reflected in this part of the report on the following aspects in 7 tables:-

- a. Total Number of Semi- Government employees according to their pay scales.
  - Number of Semi- Government employees belonging to Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen, Wards of Freedom Fighters, Handicapped, Terrorist affected and Compassionate grounds.
  - c. District-wise No. of Semi- Government employees.

#### II. Scope & Coverage

Semi- Government employees working in Boards/Corporations and Local Bodies as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010 have been covered.

#### III. Methodology

A prescribed performae was circulated to all Heads of Boards and Corporations. Information for the Semi- Government employees working in Boards and Corporations either at Chandigarh or at district level was collected by post and through personal visits. Information from Local Bodies functioning in districts was collected by district level offices of Deputy Economic & Statistical Advisers.

#### IV. Results

The total number of sanctioned posts were 150138 out of which 112234 were filled up as on 31.3. 2010 in these Boards, Corporations and Local Bodies.

#### 1. Semi- Government Employees in Boards/Corporations

A number of 73855 employees were working in Boards/Corporations as on 31.3. 2010 out of which the maximum number i.e. 14024 (18.99%) were in the pay scale of Rs.5910-20200+1650. There were 6811 (9.22%) female employees. Out of 73855 employees 17506 (23.70%) belong to Scheduled Castes,6944 (9.40 %) belong to Backward Classes, 743(1.01%) belong to Exservicemen, 274 (0.37 %) were the wards of Freedom Fighters, 200 (0.27%) were Handicapped employees, 58(0.08%) were Terrorist affected and 3129 (4.24%) were employed on Compassionate ground. 3213 (4.35%) employees have retired during the year 2009-10

#### 2. Employees of Municipal Corporations/ Municipal Committees/ Nagar Panchayats

There are 134 Municipal Corporations/Committees and Nagar Panchayats in the state. Total number of employees working in the Municipal Corporations/Committees /Nagar Panchayats as on 31.3. 2010were 26248. Out of this maximum number i.e.8866 (33.78 %) were working in the pay scale of Rs. 4900-10680+1300and 6103 (23.25 %) were female employees. Out of total

26248 filled posts, 15318(58.36 %) employees belong to Scheduled Castes, 2304 (8.78 %) belong to Backward Classes, 86 (0.33 %) belong to Exservicemen,139 (0.53 %) were the wards of Freedom Fighters, 268 (1.02 %) were Handicapped employees,115(0.44 %) were Terrorist affected and 890 (3.39 %) were employed on Compassionate ground. year 2009-10. Number of retired employees was 661 (2.52 %) during the year 2009-10.

#### 3. Employees of Improvement Trusts

There were 767 employees working in 22 Improvement Trusts in the state as on 31.3. 2010.Out of these 767 employees maximum number i.e. 151 (19.69%) were working in the pay scale of Rs.5910-20200+1900. 680(88.66%)were males and only 87 (11.34 %) were females. 158 (20.60%) employees belong to Scheduled Castes, 42 (5.48%) to Backward classes, 0 with Ex-servicemen category, 4 (0.52%) were Wards of Freedom Fighters, 5 (0.65%) were Handicapped, 2 (0.26%) were Terrorist affected and 36(4.69%) were employed on Compassionate ground and 21 employees were retired during the year.

#### 4. Employees of Zila Parishads

A number of 3421 employees were working as on 31.3.2010 in 20 Zila Parishads of the state. Out of which the maximum number i.e. 2110(61.68%) were working in the pay scale of Rs. 5910-20200+3000and 1632(47.71 %) were female employees. Out of total 3421 filled up posts, 1109 (32.42%) employees belong to Scheduled Castes, 406(11.87%) belong to Backward Classes, 238(6.96%) were Ex-servicemen,70(2.05 %) were Wards of Freedom Fighters, 89(2.60%) were Handicapped,22(0.64 %) were Terrorist affected and 109(3.19 %) were Compassionate ground employees and 32 employees were retired during the year.

#### 5. Employees of Market Committees

A number of 3480 employees employed in market committees, maximum number of employees 489(14.05%) were working in the pay scale of Rs.4900-10680+1300, 373 (10.72%) were female employees, 733 (21.06%) employees belong to Scheduled Castes, 344(9.89%) to Backward Classes, 19(0.55%) to Exservicemen Category, 15(0.43%) were Wards of Freedom Fighters, 27(0.78 %) were Handicapped, 28(0.80%) were Terrorist affected and 307 (8.82%) were Compassionate ground employees and 102 employees were retired during the year.

#### 6. Employees of Panchayat Samities

There were 141 Panchayat Samities in the state. Total number of. of employees were 4463 as on 31.3.2010 in these Panchayat Samities. Out of total 4463 employees, the maximum number i.e.1425(31.93%) were working in the pay scale of Rs.6910-20200+3000. Out of total 4463 employees 1328 (29.76%) were female employees, 1043(23.37 %) belong to Scheduled Castes, 423(9.48%) to Backward Classes, 44(0.99 %) were Ex-servicemen, 67(1.50%) were wards of Freedom Fighters, 83(1.86%) were Handicapped, 37(0.83%) were terrorist

affected and 170(3.81%) were Compassionate ground employees and 84 employees were retired during the year.


The information relating to employees working in Aided Institutions as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010 has been given in 2 tables on the following aspects:

### 1. Total Number of Employees in Aided Institutions

- **a**. Employees according to their pay scales.
- b. Number of Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen, Wards of Freedom Fighters, Handicapped, Terrorist affected and Compassionate ground employees.

The total No. of employees in Aided Institutions was 12179 as on 31.3.2010. Out of this, 1185 (9.73%) employees belong to Scheduled Castes, 647(5.31%) to Backward Classes, 117 (0.96%) to Ex-servicemen, 64 (0.53%) to wards of Freedom Fighters, 41(0.34%) to Handicapped, 16 (0.13%) to Terrorist affected and 122 (1.00%) belong to Compassionate grounds categories and 286 employees were retired during the year.


# Percentage of Employees - Govt., Semi Govt. and Aided insitutions in Punjab as on 31st march 2010




■ Punjab Govt.





## Group-wise Reservation position of Punjab Government Employees working at Chandigarh and at District level as on 31st March 2010





## Sex -wise Distribution of Employees working in Semi Govt. Institutions in Punjab as on 31st March 2010






