**Subject: Approval of Sectoral Outlay for the Annual Plan 2006-07 in respect of Punjab.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the d.o. letter No 1/8/PSPB/AP/RO (PC-II)/06/4086 dated 30.3.2006 from the Government of Punjab seeking approval of Sectoral Plan Outlay for 2006-07 amounting to Rs. 4000 crore for the State.

2. The Scheme of Financing of the approved Annual Plan 2006-07 is given at Annexure-I.

3. A statement showing the distribution of the approved Annual Plan 2006-07 among different sectors, is given at Annexure-II.

4 As already mentioned in our letter No. M-13011/3/2005-SP-C0., dated 31.10.2005 reiterating the earlier guidelines issued on the subject, it is necessary to make the Social Welfare Department/the Department concerned as the nodal Department for formulation and implementation of the SCSP. The State Government will allocate an additional amount of Rs. 2 crore for SCSP in their supplementary budget. The funds earmarked for SCSP should be placed at the disposal of the nodal Department which, in turn, will reallocate the funds to the Sectoral Departments for implementing schemes under the SCSP. The funds earmarked for SCSP should be placed under a separate budget Head/Sub-head for each implementing Department. Action may please be taken on each of the above points before 30.06.2006 and copies of the orders issued in this connection may please be made available to us latest by that date. ***Physical and financial achievements on schemes under SCSP should be got verified as per the proformae circulated by Planning Commission vide DO letter No. M-13054/2/2005-BC dated 12.1.2006.***

5. I am directed to invite your attention to the procedure for sending adjustment proposal and revision of outlays and to request you to send the adjustment proposal and proposal for revision of outlays fully supported by Revised Scheme of Financing for the Annual Plan 2006-07 if any, together with appropriate justifications, before **31<sup>st</sup> December, 2006**.

6. Statements showing actual expenditure incurred and the corresponding actual Scheme of financing of the Annual Plan 2006-07 should be sent to the Planning Commission before **30<sup>th</sup> September, 2007**.

7. The Plan Programmes need to be monitored closely with a view to achieve the financial and physical targets.
